MID-AMERICA MEMBERSHIP IS REQUIRED:

Exhibitors (defined as owners, riders and trainers in performance classes; riders and instructors only in equitation and academy classes) must be current members of Mid-America Horse Show Assn. Membership dues are: \$25 Junior (17 yrs. & under); \$25 Academy Rider; \$35 Senior (18 yrs. & over); \$40 Family; \$50 Business. Membership applications will be available at horse show office.

TROPHY AND SIX RIBBONS IN EVERY CLASS.

ALL DOGS MUST BE LEASHED.

HORSE SHOW OFFICE HOURS:

The horse show office will close one hour before each performance. Entries for classes within a performance should be made prior to that closing. Check posted hours for additional closings.

FAILURE TO SCRATCH:

A \$25 fine will be charged to any entry that fails to scratch. This applies to championships as well as preliminary classes.

SCHOOLING HOURS:

Please check for schooling hours as main arena will not be available at all times.

VET ON CALL

Phone number will be posted at show office.

NOVICE AMATEUR RIDER:

This class is open to riders who have not won three blue ribbons in any under-saddle class at a show recognized by Mid-America Horse Show Association or any other show sanctioning organization.

NOVICE/LIMIT

Novice and Limit classes are open to horses/riders that have not won three/six first place ribbons respectively at shows recognized by Mid-America Horse Show Assn. or any other show sanctioning organization.

STAKE/CHAMPIONSHIP ELIGIBILITY:

To be eligible to compete in a divisional stake or championship, a horse must be shown and judged in one other class in that division. For an Amateur Stake, a horse must have shown in an Amateur or Junior Exhibitor preliminary or in the Ladies by an amateur rider.

STABLING LIMITED - TACK STALLS LIMITED:

Due to limited number of stalls, tack stalls will be assigned on the basis of number of horses entered. No alteration of stalls permitted.

SHOWING OUT OF TRAILERS:

When stalls are "sold-out" exhibitors will be permitted to show out of trailers. A \$35 grounds fee per horse will be assessed.

STABLING AVAILABLE AFTER 10 A.M., THURSDAY, JULY 29th.

BEDDING REQUIREMENTS/COSTS:

No bedding may be brought in to Ledges. All bedding must be purchased from Ledges, \$8per bag, as it must be a specific type of shavings to meet local environmental requirements. When considering bedding costs, be aware that it includes the expense of delivery, clean-up and disposal.

HOLD HARMLESS STATEMENT:

Any and all entries in this horse show shall be conditioned upon the following additional terms and conditions: The Mid-America Signature Show, Mid-America Horse Show Assn., Ledges Sporting Horses Stables, show management, and sponsors will be in no case responsible for any loss, damage or injury that may occur and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold them harmless for any loss or injury which may occur by accident, fire, theft or otherwise.

CHOOSE "A" OR "B" SEASON TROPHY POINTS FOR EACH ENTRY

Exhibitors must declare whether their Signature show wins get A circuit or B circuit season trophy points on the Mid-America, IASPHA and ASAW high point systems. Previously, all wins got A circuit points. (Undeclared entries will get A circuit points.) Does not apply to Academy entries.

Whatever the class placing, the highest placed B entry will get the equivalent of first place points toward B circuit season trophies, the next highest B entry will get second place points, etc. The highest place A entry will get the equivalent of first place points toward A circuit season trophies, next highest A entry will get second place points, etc. Entries will be coded when show results are sent to the three affiliated organizations.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS for MID-AMERICA CLASSES at MANE EVENT SHOW

To qualify to show in any of six new Mid-America classes at the Mane Event Show, owners and riders/drivers must be current Mid-America members and horses must have competed in the same class (either qualifying or championship) at either this year's Mid-America Spring Show or Mid-America Signature Show.

Mid-America classes at Mane Event are: Show Pleasure Three Gaited Junior Exhibitor, Show Pleasure Three Gaited Adult and Show Pleasure Driving, Country Pleasure Three Gaited Junior Exhibitor, Country Pleasure Three Gaited Adult and Country Pleasure Driving.
