MID-AMERICA MEMBERS ONLY:

Exhibitors (defined as owners, riders and trainers in performance classes; riders and instructors only in equitation and academy classes) must be current members of Mid-America Horse Show Assn. Membership dues are: \$25 Junior (17 yrs. & under); \$25 Academy Rider (any age); \$35 Senior (18 yrs. & over); \$40 Family; \$50 Business. Membership applications will be available at horse show office.

USEF REQUIREMENTS:

Life, Contributing, Senior, Junior and Affiliate members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at regular member competitions. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent or trainer upon payment of a \$20.00 registration fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from this rule: Leadline, exhibitions, games and races, 4-H classes, walk/trot and academy classes. Whether member or non-member, all amateurs must possess an Amateur Card issued by USEF. Back numbers will not be released until all required credentials have been verified by the horse show office.

ASHA REQUIREMENTS FOR SADDLEBRED

ENTRIES: Every owner and trainer of a Saddlebred entry must be a current member of ASHA and send with entries a copy of membership card and a copy of registration papers showing proof of current ownership.

\$20 CHARGE FOR INCOMPLETE ENTRIES: Entries not containing all necessary documents to verify eligibility for horse/rider/owner/trainer/handler will be considered incomplete. Copies of registration papers showing proof of current ownership, copies of current USEF and ASHA membership cards must accompany entry blanks, which must include the REQUIRED three signatures and complete addresses for owners and trainers.

TROPHY AND SIX RIBBONS IN EVERY CLASS.

ALL DOGS MUST BE LEASHED.

HORSE SHOW OFFICE HOURS:

The horse show office will close one hour before each performance. Entries for classes within a performance should be made prior to that closing. Check posted hours for additional closings.

FAILURE TO SCRATCH:

A \$25 fine will be charged to any entry that fails to scratch. This applies to championships as well as preliminary classes.

SCHOOLING HOURS:

Please check for schooling hours as main arena will not be available at all times.

NEGATIVE COGGINS REQUIRED:

Every horse and pony must have a negative Coggins Test within the past year.

VET ON CALL

Phone number will be posted at show office.

UPHA 3-YEAR-OLD FINE HARNESS CLASSIC:

Open to any horse nominated and kept eligible with UPHA. \$500 will be added to entry fees collected and dispersed to winners in this classic.

NOVICE AMATEUR RIDER (not a USEF class):

This class is open to riders who have not won three blue ribbons in any under-saddle class at a show recognized by Mid-America Horse Show Assn. or any other show sanctioning organization.

JUNIOR & ADULT JUDGING CONTEST (See office for details)

STABLING LIMITED - TACK STALLS LIMITED:

Due to limited number of stalls, tack stalls will be assigned on the basis of number of horses entered.

SHOWING OUT OF TRAILERS:

When stalls are "sold-out" exhibitors will be permitted to show out of trailers. A \$35 grounds fee for the show will be assessed.

BEDDING REQUIREMENTS/COSTS:

No bedding may be brought in to Ledges. All bedding must be purchased from Ledges, \$8 per bag, as it must be a specific type of shavings to meet local environmental requirements. When considering bedding costs, be aware that it includes the expense of delivery, clean-up and disposal.

STABLING AVAILABLE AFTER 8 A.M., THURSDAY

HOLD HARMLESS STATEMENT:

Any and all entries in this horse show shall be conditioned upon the following additional terms and conditions: The Mid-America Spring Show, Mid-America Horse Show Assn., Ledges Sporting Horses Stables, show management, and sponsors will be in no case responsible for any loss, damage or injury that may occur and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold them harmless for any loss or injury which may occur by accident, fire, theft or otherwise.

WARM-UP RING SAFETY REGULATIONS:

In an effort to insure the safest possible event, only participants (riders or drivers, trainers and grooms) are permitted in the warm-up area, and then no earlier than one class before they compete. All exhibitors are asked to instruct family and friends to stay in the mezzanine seating area or view the show from the East rail.

MOTORIZED VEHICLES:

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense.
